



HLMSW Update Version 3.8.0.xx 5 November, 2009

This update includes a number of new features in preparation for the launch of Zinfonia in 2010, a number of improvements for HLMSW users that do not use the European/America character set (eg Poland, Hungary etc) and a number of other bug fixes and other changes which are listed below.

New Composer Fields

The composer entry screen has been enhanced to include option day, month and country of birth/death. *Note: Country Flags are only displayed after connection to the Zinfonia system (see below).*

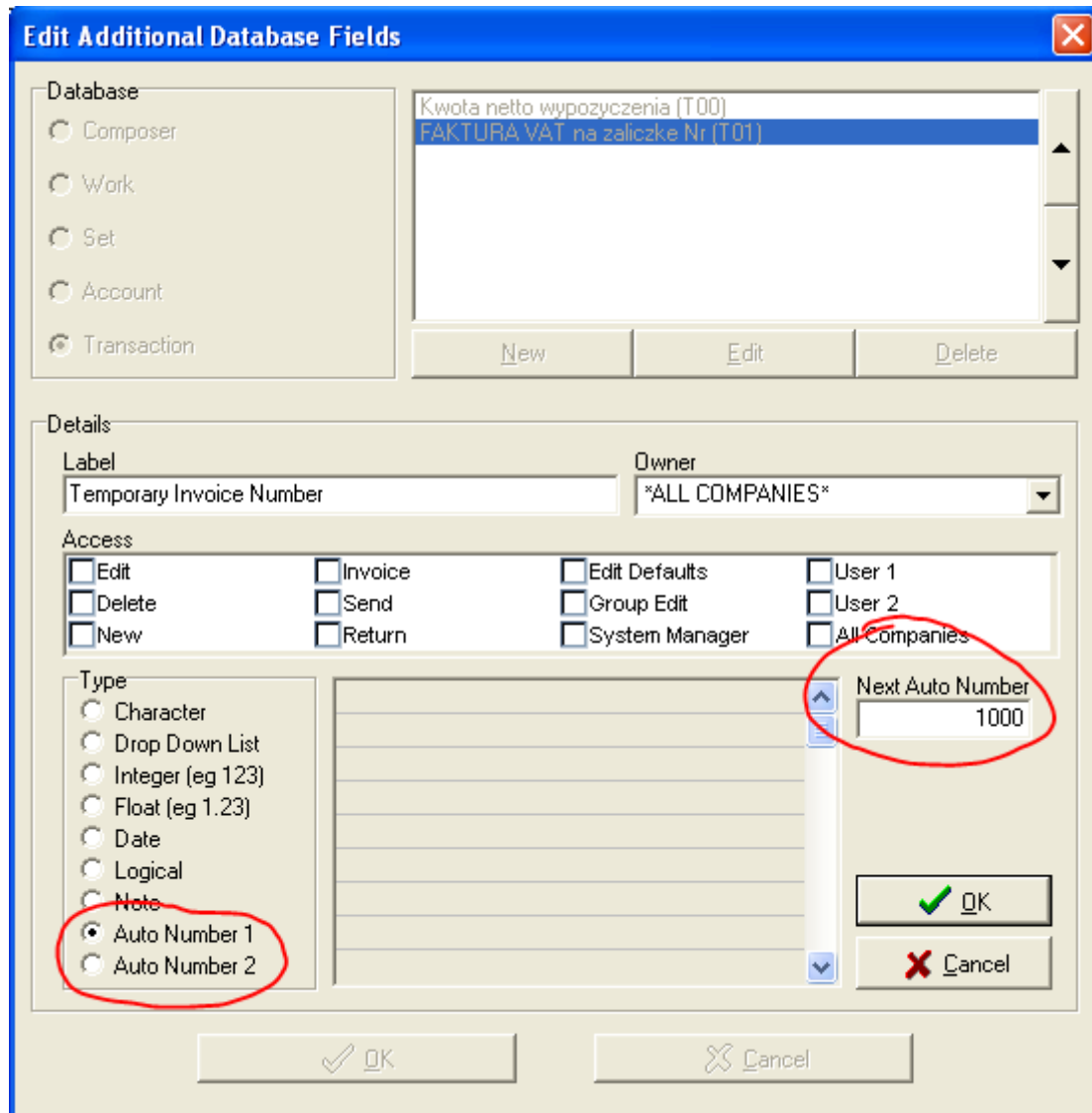

New Extra Database Field type: Auto Update Numbers

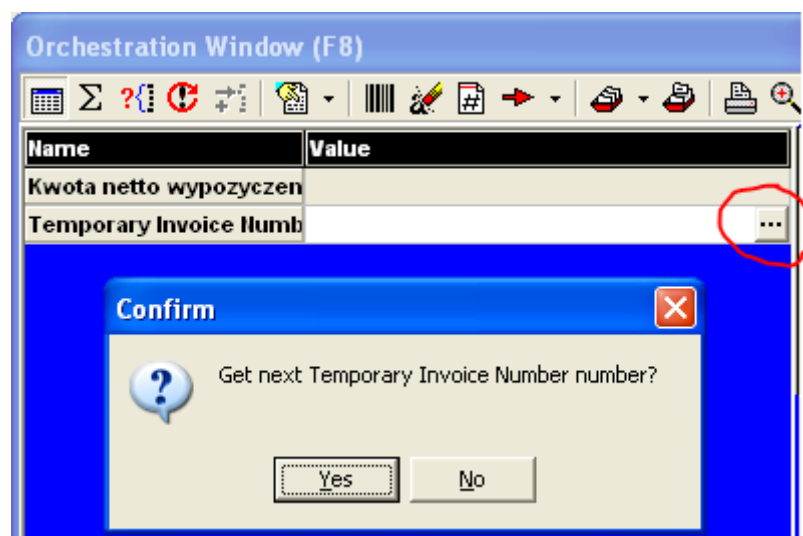
If you ever needed to keep track of a separate numerical sequence of numbers for any reason, HLMSW has two new types of extra database fields called Auto Numbers.



(Screen Shot from the HLMSW Configuration Editor *Extra Database Fields* option)

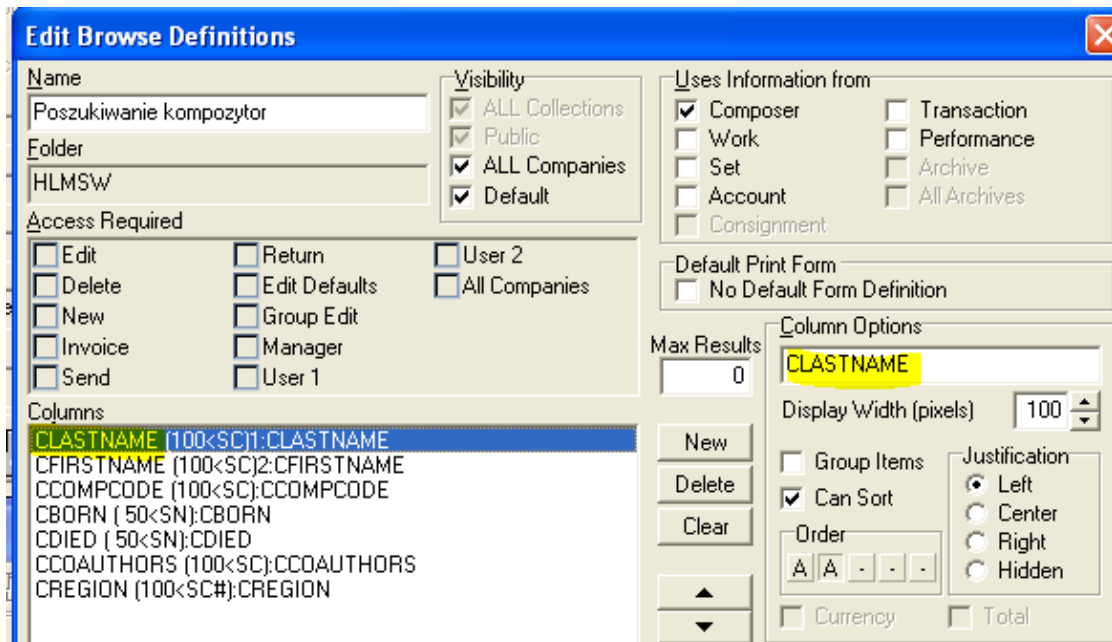
You can add these numbers to any database and HLMSW maintains the sequence using the *Next Auto Number* as the next number in the sequence.

In HLMSW, while editing the record just click on the ... button and you will be prompted to either get the next number or clear the entry (if one exists).



Automatic Translation of Browse Column names

If Browse column headings are the SAME as the fieldname then when displayed in HLMSW, it will replace the fieldname with the translation used in HLMSW if one is available.



When this browse is displayed, because the column headings are the same as the column names, the column headings will be in the language of the client:

This feature allows you to have browses with column names with extended characters.

Note: not all fields have translations available.

Negative amounts in invoices

A new option is available in the *Edit Invoice/Credit Defaults* section of the System Defaults section of the HLMSW Configuration Editor.

Central European and Eastern European languages support

HLMSW is now compatible for users of the Windows-1250 code page used under Windows to represent texts in Central European and Eastern European languages including Polish and Hungarian. In addition, support has been added for the dates in yyyy-dd-mm format.

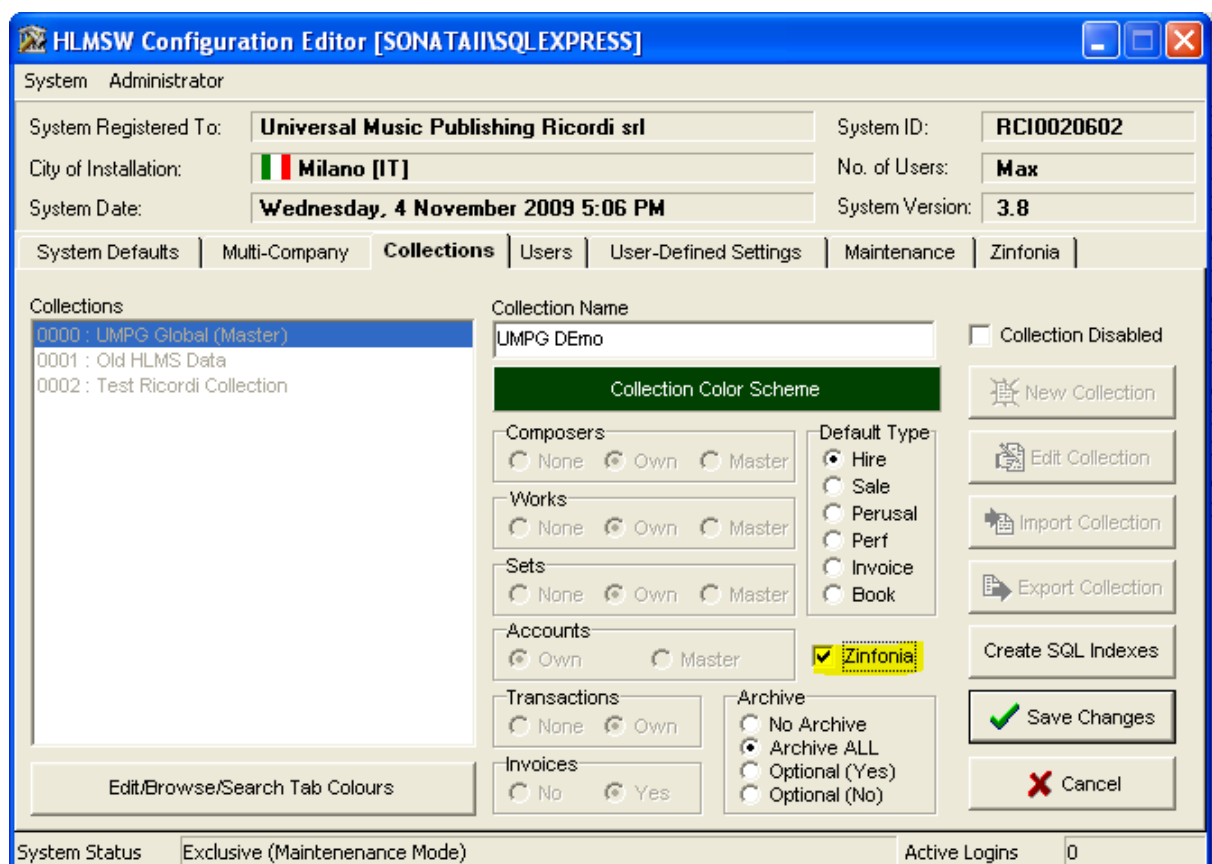
New Zinfonia Registration and Synchronisation

Note: Zinfonia is initially only open to Foundation Members of the Zinfonia Program. If you are interested in participating, please contact BTMI for more information.

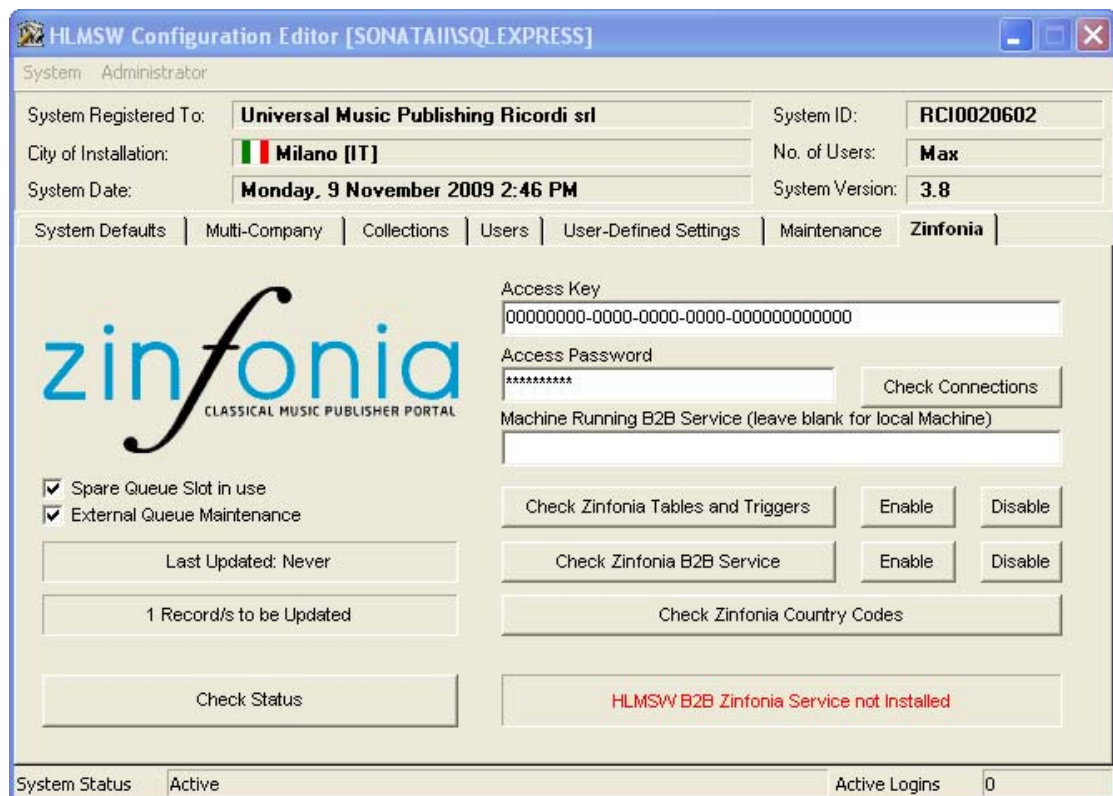
To allow for 2-way communication between your HLMSW system and the Zinfonia servers, the following procedure is required.

Using the HLMSW Configuration Editor..

- 1) Collections Tab: Mark a collection for Zinfonia by selecting the Zinfonia checkbox when editing a collection.



- 2) Zinfonia Tab : Enter Access Key and Password provided by BTMI and then the *Check Connections* button. If successful, then a *Zinfonia Access OK* message will be displayed.
- 3) Zinfonia Tab: Click on the *Check Zinfonia Tables and Triggers* button to set up your system to track changes for Zinfonia
- 4) Zinfonia Tab: Click on the *Check Zinfonia Country Codes* button to synchronise your country list with Zinfonia. When Zinfonia is enabled, maintenance of Countries is centrally managed by Zinfonia. Once synched, flags for Zinfonia-recognised countries are displayed on the Composer and Account tabs of HLMSW.
